Awards & Trophies

The League provides awards and trophies such as the MGen. Howard Award, General Walsh, Presidents award, Col Clarry and Army Cadet League Award.

The MGen. Howard Medal is presented to one Cadet in each Province to recognize cadets who complete Level 4 (Gold Star) training with exceptional results and who demonstrate significant dedication and leadership qualities.

The General Walsh Award, sponsored by the Royal Canadian Legion is presented to an Outstanding Cadet selected annually by the Army Cadet League of Canada. The selected Cadet would represent the Army Cadets from across Canada at the Remembrance Day ceremonies in Ottawa on November 11th and would receive a sword to commemorate the occasion. Applications must be submitted to the Provincial League office by May 30th annually. Criteria and applications can be accessed online from the League website www.armycadetleague.ca.

The Clarry and Army Cadet League award winners are selected from the top Strathcona Corps chosen from each Detachment that has offered the most interesting and effective training combined with the highest retention rate in Central Region. The Col. Clarry Trophy, along with \$1000. is presented to the top large Corps. The Army League Award is presented to the top small corps along with a cheque of \$500.

The Buckley Grant

A grant of \$3000. is available to Cadet Corps annually for training equipment. The Corps must submit an online application to the National League office by December 1st .

Roll Call Prize

The League awards a prize of \$500. for the best Corps newsletter and \$100. for 2nd best newsletter annually each November.

Donations

Any donations received by the Corps requiring a Charitable Tax receipt, can be sent to League Office, payable to the League and a charitable Tax Receipt will be sent out to the donor in return. The full amount of the donation will be sent to the Corps.

Donations in Kind

The League requires an invoice showing the fair market value of the donated product. However this does not apply to labour or service costs. A tax receipt will be sent to the donor.

United Way Donations

The Army Cadet League's registered charitable number is recognized by the United Way. Donors can request their United Way donations to be given to a specific Cadet Corps via the Army Cadet League or the Army Cadet League itself. This is usually arranged through payroll deductions at the place of employment.

League Insurance

The National League administers General Accident and Liability Insurance Policies for the benefit of Cadets, Volunteers, Members of the League, and Support Committee members. Proof of Insurance can be requested through the National League website in the form of a Certificate. Please request this at least one week in advance of an event, ie. tag days. Content Insurance is provided by the National League.
